Introduction

Animal Shelter Worker

- Read the text about animal shelters and answer the questions.

An animal shelter takes in homeless dogs, cats, rabbits, rats, and other pets. Some animals are temporarily separated from their owners, while others are looking for new people to live with.

- What is the difference regarding where some of the animals live before they go to a shelter?
- Where do the animals go after they have been in a shelter?



Dog Handler

- Read the text about dog handlers and answer the questions.

Dog handlers train police and guide dogs or *show off* your pup at a dog show. They teach humans to learn more about the many capabilities of our four-legged canine friends.

- Who do dog handlers train and teach? Do you think this is important? Why?
